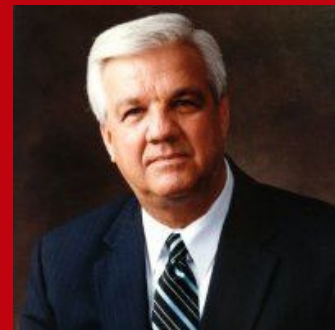
TENTATIVE TRAINING TOPICS
